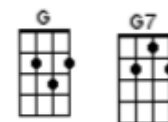
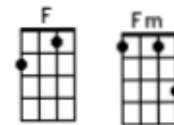
First note to sing: E

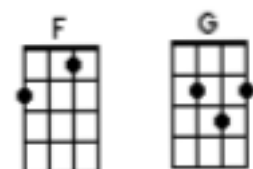
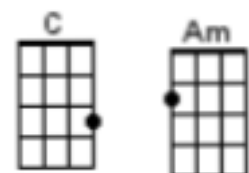
