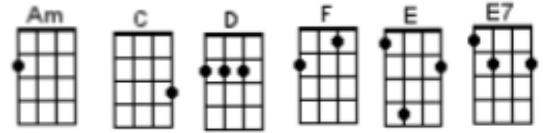


# House of the Rising Sun (The Animals)
