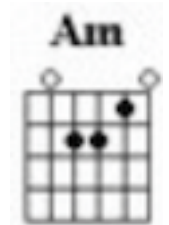
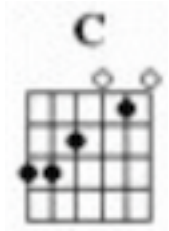


In The Bleak Midwinter

In the bleak mid-winter, long ago.

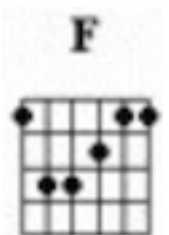


Verse 2:
