Well, you left me here so I could sit and cry

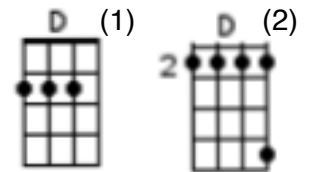
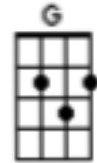
