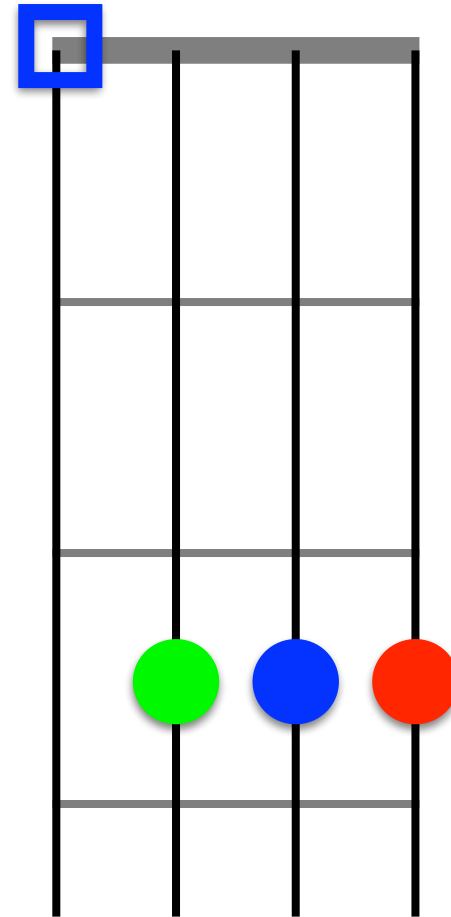


Minor Chords

Minor chords are triads (tri=3). They have a **Root**, a **Minor 3rd** which is three semitones above the root and a **5th** (also known as a **Perfect 5th**) which is five full notes or seven semitones above the **Root**)

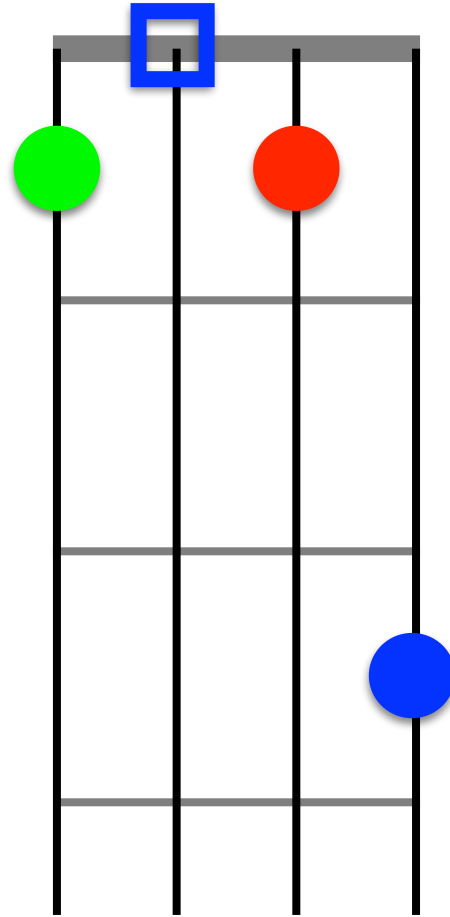

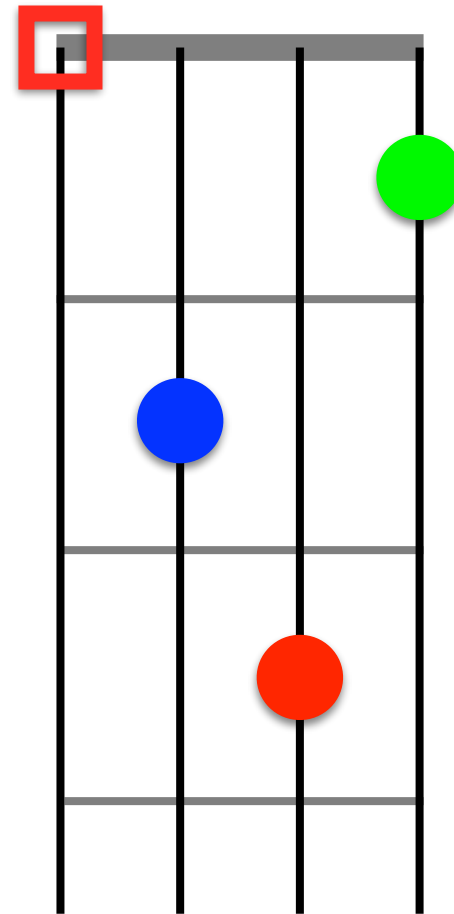

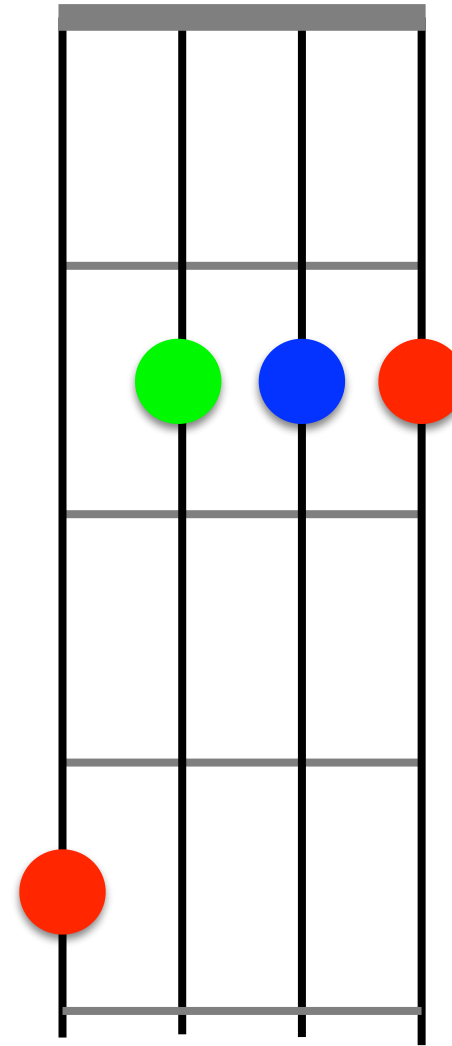
