Minor Chords


Minor chords are triads (tri=3). They have a Root, a Minor 3rd which is three semitones above the root and a 5th (also known as a Perfect 5th) which is five full notes or seven semitones above the Root)












Root: C Minor 3rd: Eb 5th: G






Root: D Minor 3rd: F 5th: A








