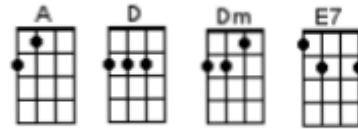


# Mirror Mirror (Pinkerton's Assorted Colours)

 Now I'm sorry, for what I've done to you.

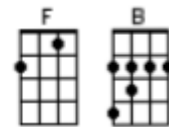
A Dm
