This is a non-profit making club. The weekly subs are to pay for the hire of the hall. Any surplus funds at the end of the year will be given to charity.

- The name of the club: RoydonStrings
- Payment of subscriptions: £3 per person per session to be paid on the evening. This may increase or decrease depending on numbers. The aim is to cover the cost of the hire of the hall.
- Location: Meetings take place in Roydon Village Hall, Harlow Road, CM19 5HH
- Meetings: Meetings are once a week for ukulele and once a week for guitar. The times are shown on the website.
- Materials: Music is provided. Members may request pieces to be included.
- Sharing materials: The materials provided (including those on the website) are for use by members only and should not be used outside RoydonStrings. Under no circumstances should they be distributed to non-RoydonStrings members.
