

Three Blind Mice

Ukulele music can be written in **tablature**.

Each line represents a string on the ukulele

The number represents the fret number - so here you have to press the E string on the 3rd fret.

```
A |-----|-----|-----|-----|
E | -0-----| -0-----| -3-1-1-0-| -3-1-1-0-|
C | ---2-0-| ---2-0-|-----|-----|
G |-----|-----|-----|-----|
```

Ignore these lines - they just divide up the music into smaller chunks.

```
A | ---3-3-2-0-2-3-----| ---3-3-3-2-0-2-3-----|
E | -3-----| -3-----| -3-----| -3-3-|
C |-----|-----|-----|-----|
G |-----|-----|-----|-----|
```

A zero means you pluck the string without holding it onto a fret.

```
A |-----3-3-2-0-2-3-----|-----|
E | -3-3-----| -3-3-3-| -1-0-|
C |-----|-----|-----2-0-|
G |-----|-----|-----|
```

Try the first section first...

which is then repeated...

```
A |-----|
E | -0-----|
C | ---2-0-|
G |-----|
```

before going on to the next section...

which is also repeated...

```
|-----|
| -3-1-1-0-|
|-----|
|-----|
```

and get these right before going on to the hardest part...

which you have to play **three** times with some slight variations.

```
A | ---3-3-2-0-2-3-----|
E | -3-----| -3-3-|
C |-----|-----|
G |-----|-----|
```
