

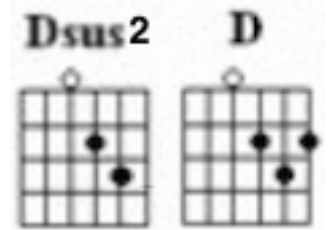
# Twenty Four Hours From Tulsa (Dusty Springfield)

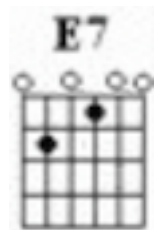
**First notes to sing:** E F#

And I'm not the same any-more

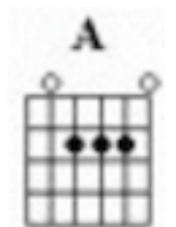


**Chorus:**

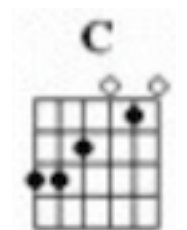
G Em

Of a small mot-el, he was there.

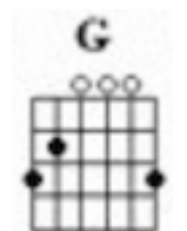


Dsus2 ^ D Dsus2^D Dsus2^D
