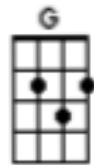
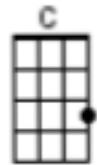


# While Shepherds Watched Their Flocks

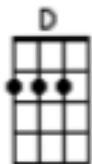
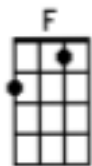
## Verse 1:

And glory shone a-round.



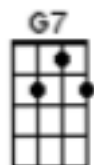
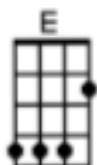
## Verse 2:

To you and all man-kind."



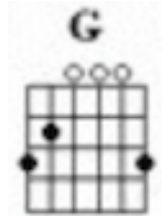
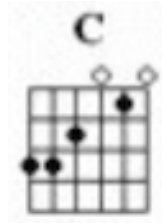
## Verse 3:

And this shall be the sign.



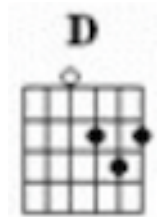
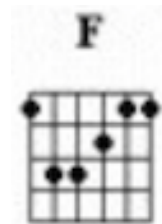
**Verse 4:**
