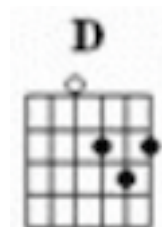
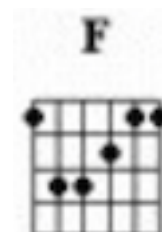
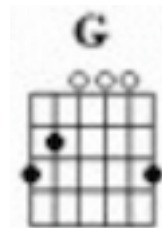
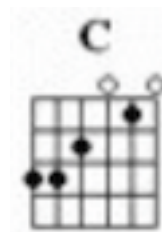
Verse 1:

And glory shone a-round.



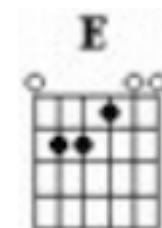
Verse 2:

Is born of David's line.

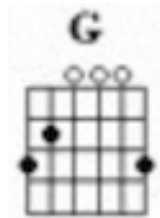
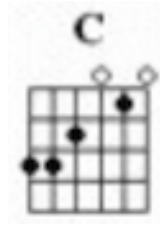

And this shall be the sign.



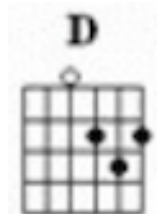
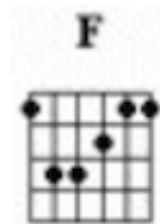
Verse 4:
